Key targets the Fund should divest from

Israeli banks directly financing the illegal settlements

- Bank Leumi has branches in the settlements and stakes in several companies involved in the occupation: Paz Oil, Super Pharm, Hot Communication Systems, and Israel Chemicals.
- Mizrahi Bank has branches in the illegal West Bank settlements.
- Bank Hapoalim provides mortgages for houses in the illegal settlements and has provided finance for at least two settlement constructions.

Weapons manufacturers

- United Technologies supply Blackhawk helicopters used by Israel to attack civilian populations.
- Boeing sells F-15A fighter jets and Apache AH 64 helicopters used by the Israeli military in attacks on Gaza.
- General Dynamics manufactures bombs and engines for Israel's Merkava tanks. Raytheon produces bombs used in attacks on Gaza.
- Israel Chemicals (ICL) supplied white phosphorus used to attack civilians in Gaza in 2014.



Infrastructure of occupation and incarceration

- Hewlett Packard provides technology, equipment and IT services to the Israeli military, and for the checkpoints and ID card system that impose movement restrictions on Palestinians.
- Caterpillar supplies bulldozers used to destroy Palestinian homes, orchards and

olive groves in the Occupied Territories, to clear land for the illegal settlements, apartheid walls and segregated roads.

• **G4S** is a security supplies equipment and services used to run the checkpoints and the prisons where thousands of Palestinian political prisoners are held, including many children. Although G4S announced in early 2016 plans to withdraw from Israel after losing billions of dollars in contracts due to their complicity, they have yet to act and are still a crucial target for divestment.
